ENGLISH



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This week we will focus on oral language and one of our remaining writing genres - **PERSUASIVE WRITING**. We will go back to our geography topic for April for inspiration - Rural vs Urban Living.

I would like everyone to write a speech that will last 2 MINUTES. Practice it out loud and when you are ready record yourself on audio or video saying your speech and send it to me via your seesaw account. If you would rather not be on camera if you use video just press record, place the phone face down and speak - I know lots of secondary school pupils prefer doing it this way and that's fine with me! Nobody but myself and Ms. O'Connor will see/hear the speeches.

The motion for the speech is
RURAL LIVING IS SUPERIOR TO URBAN LIVING

There will be two groups - for and against. To keep it simple and as even as possible I am requesting that all boys argue for the motion and all girls argue against the motion.

Those in the FOR group are preparing and giving a speech informing us why rural living **IS SUPERIOR** to urban living. Those in the AGAINST group are preparing and giving a speech informing us why rural living **IS NOT SUPERIOR** to urban living. Think in terms of health (both mental and physical), commuting, schools, shops and services and anything else you can think of.

The first line of your speech will be:

"My name is and I will be arguing FOR/AGAINST the motion that Rural Living is superior to Urban Living."

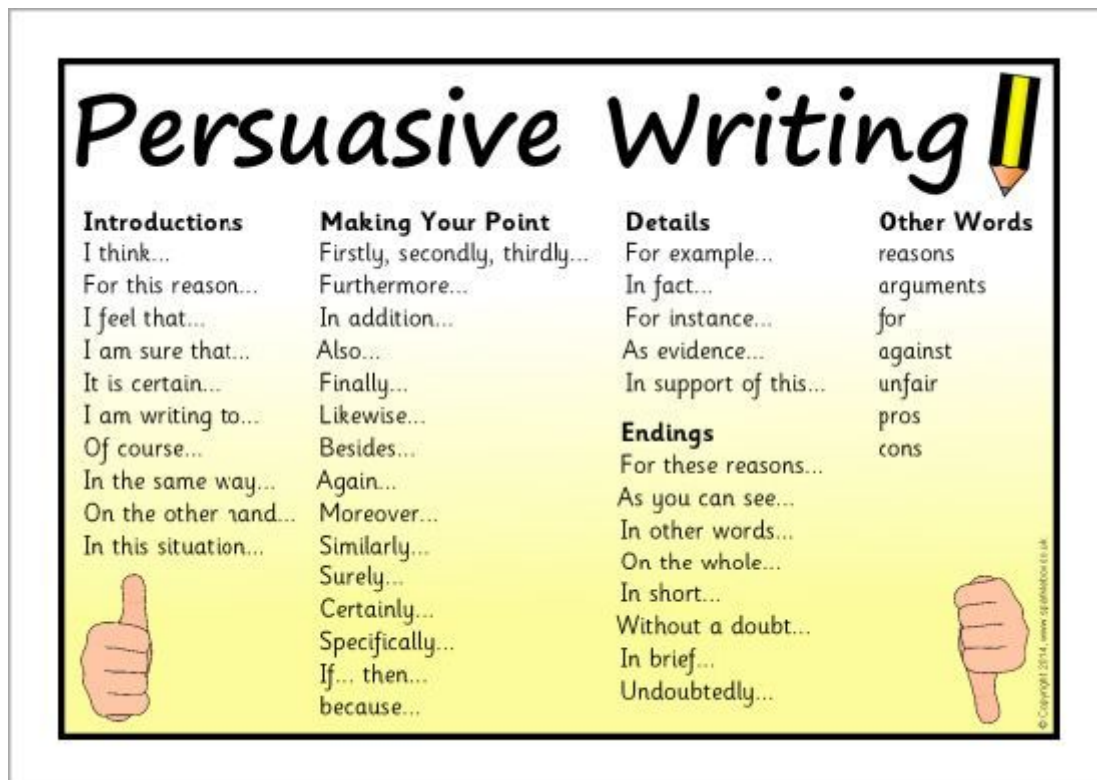
The last line of your speech will be:

"And that is why I think the motion Rural Living is Superior to Urban Living should be CARRIED/ NOT CARRIED"

Myself and Ms. O'Connor will listen to the speeches and decide whether the motion is 'carried' or not. Watch this video to see examples of good arguments for and against the wearing of school uniforms.

2. Time management (speech should be within 15 seconds of 2 minutes - at the shortest 1:45 and at the longest 2:15).
3. Structure - you should have a clear opening statement, a set of at least five arguments with reasons for the argument being made and a clear conclusion.
