Aistear Ideas	Tricky Word Games
	<p>Against the Clock</p> <p>Speed and fluency are very important when it comes to reading tricky words and this game is great for developing these qualities. This is good in partners. One child has an egg timer, the other has a pile of tricky words. You have a minute to read as many as you can, then your partner has a go.</p> <p>Snap</p> <p>This is a 'tricky word' version of the classic card game. This is good played in pairs or a small group. Ask your child to deal out a pile of tricky word flashcards to whoever is playing (or deal for them if necessary). Then they take turns to put one card on the table and read the word. The next player puts one on top and reads the word. Continue until you get two the same. The winner is the person who puts their hand on them first and shouts 'Snap!'</p>
	<p>Tricky Words Go Fish</p> <p>This is a tricky word version of Go Fish. Deal 4/5 tricky word flash cards to each player, the remaining cards go into a stack. Player A will choose one of their cards and read the tricky word e.g 'the'. Player A then chooses another player and asks 'Player B do you have the word 'the'?' If Player B has the requested card they must give it to Player A. If Player B does not have the requested card they must say 'Go Fish'. Player A will then choose the top card from the stack.</p> <p>If a player collects both cards of a particular word pair, they put them in a face-up stack in front of them. The game continues until someone has no cards left or the face-down stack runs out. The winner is the player with the most pairs of matching cards.</p> <p>Memory Game</p> <p>This game is best played with 2 - 3 players. Choose 4/5 tricky word pairs and turn them face down. Player A chooses two cards and turns them over. Player A should read both words. If the cards match Player A will keep the pair. If the cards do not match Player A must turn the cards over again. Player B then takes their turn. The winner is the player with the most pairs at the end of the game.</p>
