March

Coming up in April

Swimming

Green Schools Workshops

We continue to work towards our third Green Flag on the theme of Travel. Our travel office Tom from An Taisce, has visited our school to meet the Green Schools Committee and to carry out a Walkability Audit in the school environs. He will return to our school after Easter to carry out two workshops. Details are below. The Scooter Workshop will take place on April 25th. The Food Miles Workshop date is yet to be confirmed.

• Scooter Workshop - Infants to 2nd class

Children will learn the basics of scooter safety like how to break, road safety on a scooter and will also play some games. For this children may bring their own scooter and helmet. For pupils who do not have a scooter they can share with a friend.

• Food Miles Workshop - 3rd to 6th class

Children will discuss the concept of a carbon footprint and investigate how far our food travels and what we can do to ensure the food we eat has less emissions i.e. buying local, growing food ourselves, eating seasonally.
