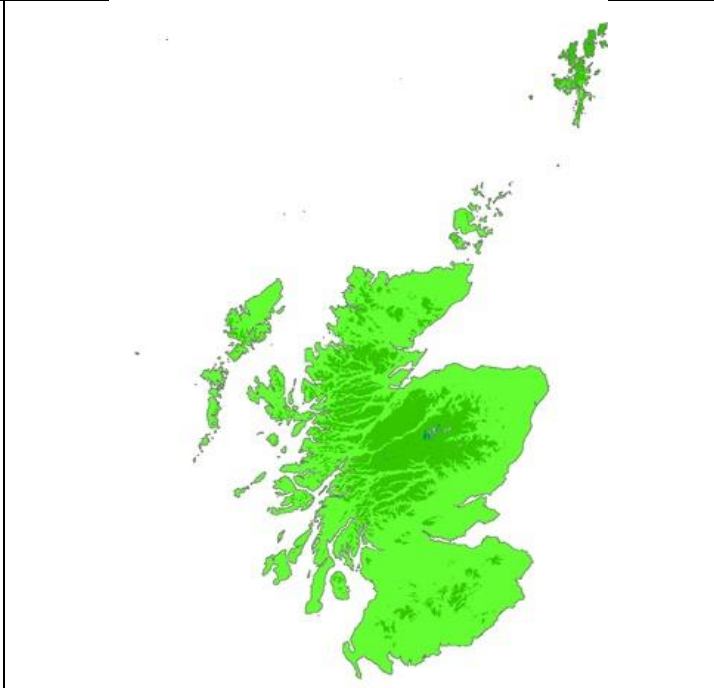


My Scotland Fact File

Scotland is part of the UK along with England, Wales and Northern Ireland.

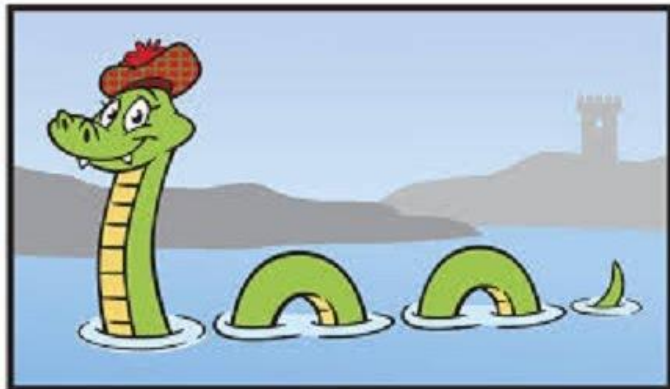
Scotland shares a border with England.
