What number is before/after 8? What numbers is eight between?

Formation of 8 - Rhyme

Make an S and do not wait go back up and that's an eight.

Use your maths copy book to practice the number formation.

Make sets of eight in your home eg. 8 lego blocks, 8 toy cars, 8 cuddly toys.

Use 8 lollipop sticks to make different shapes.

Complete pages 50-53 in the big Busy at Maths.

If you have chalk practice writing your numbers outside ,even draw hopscotch and play.
